

## Quest 4: Searching Ulukau – the Hawaiian Electronic Library

**Ulukau:** the Hawaiian Electronic Library includes a number of digitized books on Hawaiian culture, history and language.

1 Go to [ulukau.org](http://ulukau.org)

2 This site is in Hawaiian. If you prefer English, click **ENGLISH TEXT.**



3 Enter your search term here. Insert the diacritical markers ('okina and kahakō) using the blue buttons. Try your search with and without the diacritics.




4 The books in Ulukau are divided into 5 categories: Special Features, Beginners, Intermediate, General and Reference. Scroll down to the Intermediate & General categories, they will probably be the most useful for you.



5 Click a book title that looks relevant. The number of matches indicates the number of times your search term is found within the book. The more matches the better!

6 Click "Original Images" for a PDF of the original book page or "Text" for searchable text. Both are versions of the same page.
